Step 1 – Pre-Registration For Currently Enrolled Families

Forms will be sent out via Brightwheel to complete pre-registration. You should receive an automated notification via email when the forms are available. Completing these forms ahead of time will ensure the student’s Brightwheel Account is properly set up to enable a seamless class selection on Registration Day! The pre-registration forms include:
